Safe Motherhood Fund Support

Safe motherhood fund support program has been started in nine villages of Dhola VDC from February. The main objective of the program is to financially help the pregnant women and children under 5 years old of Dhola VDC. To reduce maternal and neonatal mortality and morbidities, SN has distributed Rs. 5000 each to nine mothers' group of Dhola VDC for endowment fund

establishment. It was decided to assign the interest rate according to the decision of mothers' group. The program was facilitated by IERP (Integrated Earthquake Recovery Project) Project Coordinator, Community Health Facilitator and Dhola Health Incharge.

Home Visitation Program

Home visitation program for lactating mothers was organized in six project VDCs, Maidi, Dhola, Chainpur, Salang, Nalang and Khari of Dhading district under MNCH (Maternal & Newborn Child Health) project in the month

of February. This program intended to promote healthy mothers, babies and families by evaluating on pregnancy, woman's health, infant health and child development. 30 mothers were visited in the active involvement of FHV (Female Health Volunteers), Chairperson of the local mothers' group and SN CHF (Community Health Facilitator). They gave information on various suggestions on benefits of delivering in health post, breast feeding, regular vaccination and growth monitoring scale. Mothers were happy to receive the various kinds of nutritious food like fruits, ghee, egg, local chicken etc. from the visitors.

Hygiene Promotional Activity


SN conducted hygiene promotional education program at the schools of Chainpur, Gajuri, Kumpur and Dhola VDCs in February. 434 students learned to wash hand and brush teeth in proper way. They made the commitment to teach their family members to properly brush teeth every twice a day and wash hand. They started to manage the wastages of school premises every Friday of a week.

Nutrition Education Orientation

4 Group Education Orientation program on local food and nutrition value was conducted at Benighat, Jogimara and Mahadevsthan VDCs in February. The objective of the program is to enable the target communities to acquire the knowledge about the nutritional qualities of the foods they consume and to be protected from inaccurate processed foods. 91 mothers knew the benefits of eating food that was grown or produces in their own field which contains a higher nutritional value. They made the commitment to feed their family from own produced vegetables rather than buying from outside to improve the nutrition level of their family.

Donor Monitoring Visit

SN donor, MTI (Medical Teams International), USA performed a monitoring visit to Nalang and Salang, northern VDCs of Dhading district where they visited outreach clinic, health post and had a interaction with the mothers' group regarding maternal & newborn child health care. Mothers' group welcomed the guests with health related awareness song and various activity program.

BPP Orientation

BPP (Birth Preparedness Plan) orientation workshop was conducted at Maidi, Dhola, Chainpur, Khari and Salang VDCs in the month of February. The workshop was focused on an intensive care for pregnant women to ensure a better quality life and to provide better conditions for childbirth. 308 mothers were well informed about the importance of maternal check-up and the risk symptoms during pregnancy. Participants of Chainpur VDC Assistants from respective VDCs Health post facilitated the program. Participants made the commitment to promote health education to improve 100 % safe delivery and intensive care of child and mother.

Planning Workshop

SN facilitated planning workshop with disable concern coordination committee of Nalang, Salang and Dhola VDCs In February. The workshop aims to identify the people with disabilities to make the



life easier by supporting the necessary materials and establishing strong bond relationship within them. Annual work plan has been prepared and submitted to the respective VDC office.

Health Education

SN facilitated health education orientation program among the mothers' group of Sertung and Jharlang in February. The main purpose of the program is to increase the volume of pregnancy test and encourage them for institutional delivery. 129 participants learnt the importance of frequent checkup on pregnancy, vaccination and intake of iron pills.

ARI Health Education

ARI (Acute Respiratory Infection) Health Education was conducted at four VDCs, Maidi, Chainpur, Khari and Salang in the month of February. SN CHFs, and Health Assistants from respective VDCs Health post facilitated on the respiratory disease and its prevention among children below 5 years old. 6 Health Education Programs were conducted in four VDCs where 238 participants learned to identify the symptom of pneumonia and its home remedies.

ANC Camp

SN organized 13 ANC (Antenatal care) and PNC (Postnatal Care) camp at 6 VDCs, Khari, Nalang, Salang, Dhola, Maidi and Chainpur in February. 396 mothers' group members acquired the knowledge on the importance of ANC and PNC.
